 Insurance costs and natural disaster risks and reconstructions are major drivers of current FL and SWFL real estate markets


Housing attainability critical to SWFL long-term growth







SWFL Population

Net Migration by Source










SWFL economy is showing some declining...





Percent change compared to a year ago





Percent change compared to a year ago









Year-to-year change in employment






Year-to-year percentage point change in seasonally-adjusted unemployment rate




